

## Term Project Update

Please submit an update of your proposed term project in pdf format by Thursday 25 October. This should give

- the proposed project title and your name
- objective for your term project
- the data that you propose to use and how you will get it, and
- if possible an outline of steps you need to complete to do the project.
- *A base map of your project area*

The project does not have to address a unique research question. If you are doing a thesis or dissertation, and there is a GIS aspect to that, you are encouraged to frame a project topic around that. It is perfectly fine and encouraged for your project to contribute towards and help set up your thesis work. In writing the project proposal, a useful approach is to “focus first on the data you can get, and then think about the questions you can answer with those data”. This helps ensure that there is data for you to work with, rather than searching for data to answer a question where there may not be data to answer it.
